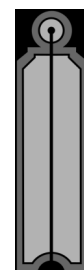
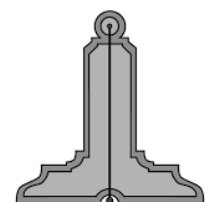
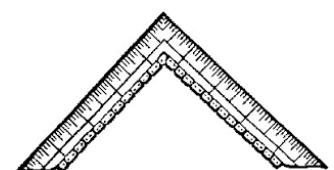
Stay tuned next month for insight into the meaning of my pin.

Again, thank you for the opportunity to serve the Masons of Colorado as your Grand Master.

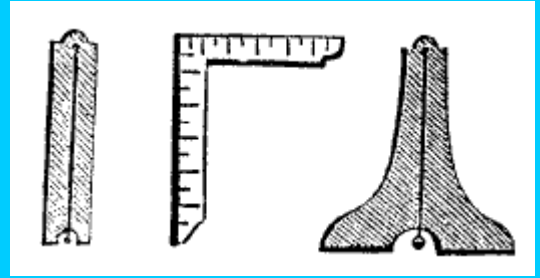
