A certified member of the CSMB will be provided and reimbursed for travel expenses for these purposes through funding from the Grand Lodge Masonic Education Committee. Your Lodge can now bring quality speakers from locations across the state for presentations at no expense to your Lodge. Note: funds are budgeted for this project, however, since this is a new program, funds are limited and will be provided on a first come, first served basis. This coming year will provide a baseline for future years funding.

In order to maintain the quality and integrity of the program, speakers for the CSMB must undergo an evaluation process for the quality of their presentation to ensure that it is engaging, appropriate and of interest to Masons.
